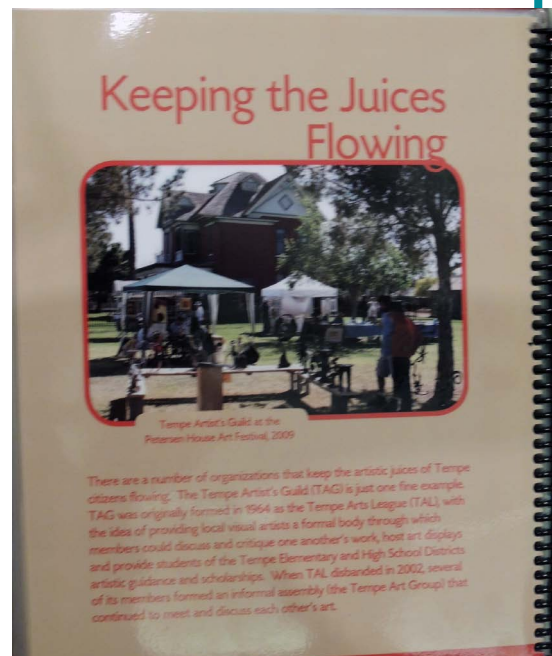

"This year I will be participating in the Dayspring Holiday Boutique the weekend of November 13 - 15.

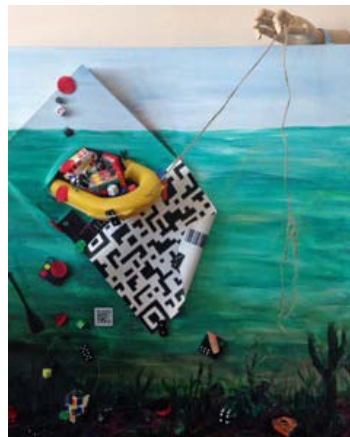

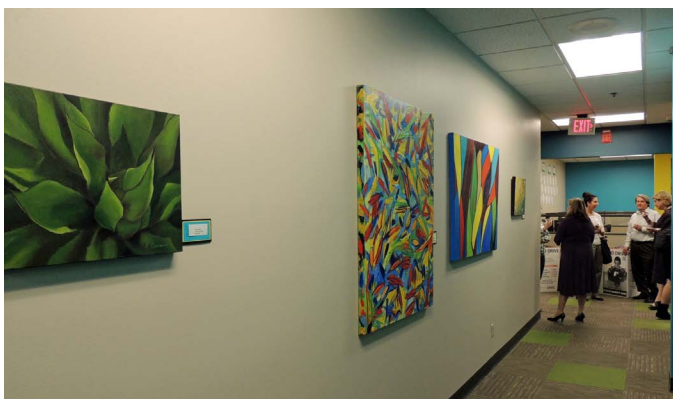
